



MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct applies to all members of Wrexham Women Supporters Group. All members agree to abide by this Code as a condition of membership.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to ensure that the Group provides a positive, inclusive, and safe supporter environment that reflects the values of women's football, Wrexham AFC Women, and the wider community.

2. General Behaviour

Members must:

- Act responsibly and respectfully at all times
- Support the aims, values, and reputation of the Group
- Follow stadium regulations, steward instructions, and relevant laws
- Represent Wrexham AFC Women and the local community positively

3. Equality, Inclusion, and Respect

The Group operates a zero-tolerance policy towards:

- Racism
- Sexism
- Homophobia
- Transphobia
- Disability discrimination
- Harassment, bullying, or abuse of any kind

This applies at matches, on organised travel, at events, and online.

4. Matchday and Supporter Activity

The Group encourages positive supporter culture, including:

- Singing and chanting
- Flags, banners, and visual displays
- Creative, non-offensive atmosphere building

Our Aim is to positively support our team, avoiding interactions with away club supporters that may be in direct conflict to this policy.

The following are strictly prohibited:

- Unauthorised pyrotechnics
- Violence, threats, or intimidation
- Pitch incursions
- Damage to property
- Offensive, abusive, or discriminatory chants

All supporter activity must be safe, inclusive, and compliant with ground regulations.

5. Travel and Events

On any travel or event organised by the Group:

- Members must behave responsibly
- Members must follow organiser instructions
- Members may be removed from travel or events for behaviour that risks safety or reputation

6. Social Media and Public Representation

Members must:

- Not claim to speak on behalf of the Group unless authorized
- Avoid posting content that brings the Group into disrepute
- Treat players, officials, opposition supporters, and volunteers with respect

7. Safeguarding and Young Members

The welfare of young supporters is a priority.

Child members must be accompanied by a parent or guardian where appropriate.

Safeguarding concerns will be taken seriously and acted upon.

8. Breaches and Enforcement

Breaches of this Code will be handled in accordance with the Group's disciplinary procedures.

Sanctions may include warnings, suspension, or removal from membership.

Serious breaches may result in immediate action or report to outside agencies.
